The purpose of travel to the United Kingdom is to work as a seasonal worker in the edible horticulture sector for [name and address of employer] on [commencement date]. This purpose of travel is exempt from Regulations 7 and 8 to the extent specified by Regulation 10(4)(g) of the Regulations: to carry out specified activities in relation to edible horticulture, but only if P is residing at the premises in connection with those activities.

You are therefore required to self-isolate for 14 days on the specified farm, but you are able to begin work immediately. However, you must at all times follow the relevant guidance from the Welsh Government:
